Applicant must also meet the following admission criteria for Joint WSCC/ATSU:

- Be unconditionally admitted to ATSU and WSCC.
- Be in good standing with ATSU and WSCC.
- Submit nursing application with required documents and official transcripts before posted deadline.
- Complete all required academic courses prior to application deadline for admission points. ATSU will allow for courses to be in progress, but must be completed prior to program start.
- Maintain a grade of “C” or better in ALL general education and nursing courses.
- A minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA for all college course work.
- A minimum GPA of 2.5 is necessary for nursing required academic courses.
- Complete all required academic courses prior to admission deadline.
- A minimum 20 ACT composite score or superscore (National or Residual).
- ACT test scores and credit for academic courses do not have an expiration date.

Applicant must meet the following before final program admission:

- Essential functions: Applicant must possess a functional level of ability to perform the duties required of a nurse.
- Clinical Requirements including immunizations, health insurance, access to transportation, background check and drug and alcohol screening.

Wallace State Joint Enrollment Program requires a minimum ACT score of 20 (composite or superscore) regardless of date taken. To obtain ACT test scores, check high school transcript or order the results from ACT. On the ACT website search for: Sending Your Scores, then follow the directions. The test scores will be sent to Wallace State Community College (Center Code 0083). If an ACT test is needed, the residual is offered on campus.
