### Joint Mobility Enrollment Program

March 15<sup>th</sup> thru May 15<sup>th</sup> for Fall Entry

#### Mobility Applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Awarded an AAS Degree in a related field from a regionally accredited college or university.
- Currently licensed as an Emergency Medical Services-Paramedic, Diagnostic Imaging, Diagnostic Medical Sonographer, Medical Laboratory Technician, Occupational Therapy Assistant, Physical Therapist Assistant, Respiratory Therapist or awarded a certificate and licensed as a Practical Nurse in the State of Alabama.
- It is suggested that non-nursing applicants review information on basic nursing care and may seek Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) certification.
- It is recommended that applicants have at least six months of direct patient care experience in their field of study prior to application.
- Students will be ineligible to apply for NUR 209 if they have experienced a withdrawal or non-progression in any previous mobility curriculum including, but not limited to NUR 200, NUR 201 or NUR 209. Students will be eligible to apply to the traditional nursing program. Admission is not guaranteed.

#### ACT Testing Resources

Wallace State Joint Enrollment Program requires a minimum ACT score of 20 (composite or superscore) regardless of date taken.

To obtain ACT test scores, check high school transcript or order the results from ACT. On the ACT website search for: Sending Your Scores, then follow the directions. The test scores will be sent to Wallace State Community College (Center Code 0083).

#### Applicant must also meet the following admission criteria for Joint Mobility WSCC/UAB:

- Be unconditionally admitted to UAB and WSCC.
- Be in good standing with UAB and WSCC.
- Submit nursing application with required documents and official transcripts before posted deadline.
- Complete all required academic courses prior to application deadline for admission points. UAB will allow for courses to be in progress, but must be completed prior to program start.
- Maintain a grade of “C” or better in ALL general education and nursing courses.
- A minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA for all college course work.
- A minimum GPA of 2.5 is necessary for nursing required academic courses.
- Complete all required academic courses prior to admission deadline.
- A minimum 20 ACT composite score or superscore (National or Residual).
- ACT test scores and credit for academic courses do not have an expiration date.

#### Applicant must meet the following before final program admission:

- Essential functions: Applicant must possess a functional level of ability to perform the duties required of a nurse.
- Clinical Requirements including immunizations, health insurance, access to transportation, background check and drug and alcohol screening.
